

# Vocabulary Flashcards

## "Natural Bridge Waterfall"

Hey you,

Here are some ideas on how to practise vocabulary when using flashcards.

### Learn

Each flashcard contains two sides: One side displays the *term* and the opposite side displays the *definition* and some visual aid. Take some time to analyse and understand each definition.

### Memory Game (1+ players)

Place the flashcards pile down, with the terms facing up and the definitions facing down. Pick one card at a time and try to guess its definition. Flip the card and check the definition. Were you correct?

Play the memory game with friends!

### Categorise (1+ players)

Each *term* can be a noun (n.), an adjective (adj.), an adverb (adv.), a verb, etc., known as *word classes*. Try to guess which kind of word it is before categorising each card into its respective *word class*.

### Timed Quiz (2+ players)

If you're competitive, test your friends' knowledge of the vocabulary and time them. Can they give you the definition in under 5 seconds?

It's okay if you don't get it right the first couple of times. The most important thing is for you to have fun !



**rushing** *adj.*


water moving quickly

**slippery** *adj.*


difficult to hold because it

**roaring** *adj.*


active, strong or very loud



**echoes**


**echoes** *n.*
